- Amenities** *Basic amenities are provided in all rooms for the first night of stay. Additional items are available at the front desk. Cable TV, microwave, fridge, digital AM/FM radio, and bath linens are provided in all rooms. Coffee is provided in all rooms and coffee service is available 24 hours a day to all guests in the business center.*
- ATM** *The nearest ATM is located inside the NEX/Commissary Complex and available during NEX operating hours (see Base Facilities). An ATM is also located at the Lakehurst Naval Federal Credit Union with 24 hour access (📍 on the Lakehurst Map in this directory)*

Hours of Operation: Wednesday and Thursday 1000-1400*
- Business Center** *The lodging business center is located adjacent to the front desk. Services provided are Wireless HSI, Copier, Fax, Printer, and Scanner. Business center is open 24 hours; please sign in at front desk for use.*
- Bicycles** *Bicycles are not permitted in any lodging facility. Please use the bicycle rack located by the back entrance.*
- Check Cashing** *Checks can only be accepted for the amount due. For your convenience, checks may be cashed at the Lakehurst Naval Federal Credit Union {subject to Credit Union check cashing policy.}*
- Check-in Time** *Check-in time is 1500 hours or as soon as the room is clean and available. Please check with the front desk to see if your room is available for immediate occupancy.*
- Check-out Time** *We wish you didn't have to leave at all. But if you must, please remember check-out time for all lodging facilities is 1100 hours.*

Housekeeping

We strive daily to provide you with a clean room with sufficient linens, towels, and amenities, unless you have a “Do Not Disturb” sign on your door. If this sign is present, the housekeeper will not provide any services. In order to provide daily housekeeping service to your room, you must remove your “Do Not Disturb” sign not later than 1300 hours. “Do Not Disturb” may not be posted more than 72 hours. Your cooperation in this matter is appreciated.

Daily service requirements include:

- *Coffee/tea setup restocked*
- *Sweep and or vacuum floors*
- *Bed made daily*
- *Clean bathroom toilets, showers, and tubs*
- *Clean bathroom vanities, sinks, and mirrors*
- *Towels exchanged daily or project planet is followed*

Extended Stay Service Requirements include:

- *Sheets are changed and bed is made IAW AF Inns Standards*
- *Light dusting is completed/furniture polished*
- *Shower curtain/door clean*

Ice Machines

Ice machine is located on the first floor inside the laundry room.

Internet Connection

HSI is provided free to all guests. Instructions are located in the Telephone Information Tab of this directory.

Laundry

Washer and dryers are located on the first floor and are free of charge for lodging guests. Laundry soap, softener, and powder bleach are available at the front desk for purchase.

Linen

Towels are changed daily and linens weekly, unless otherwise directed through project planet. Please do not use towels/linens for anything except for their intended use, or you will be charged the replacement cost of linens.



Lost and Found *To inquire about an item that may have been lost or found at All American Inns, Please contact the Front Desk by dialing “*” from you guestroom telephone.*

Mail *Military personnel on temporary duty (TDY) or permanent change of station (PCS) status to NSA Lakehurst and want to receive personal mail during their stay, should contact the Postal Service Center (PSC) about getting a P.O. Box for the duration of their stay. Temporary Duty or Permanent Change of Station orders may be required during registration for a P.O. box. The PSC is located, 38 Lansdown Rd, hours of operation 1000-1300 or call (723)323-2534 if you have questions about getting a mail box. Personnel mail cannot be delivered through front desk. Other commercial carriers such as Fed Ex, UPS, DHL, etc., can also deliver packages to the Postal Service Center however they will not accept COD deliveries. For all outgoing mail, there is a letter box in the front lobby for your convenience. Pickup is Monday – Friday at 1500 hours.*

Maintenance *Lodging Maintenance and Civil Engineering strive to maintain high standards of maintenance in all of our rooms. Contact the front desk with any needed repair or replacement of items in your room.*

Messages *To obtain your messages, please refer to the telephone instructions provided in this directory.*

Occupant *All occupants are responsible for any damages to the rooms or furnishings. Guardians are responsible for the actions of their dependents. Charges for damages beyond fair wear and tear will be assessed based on a case by case basis. Never leave young children unattended.*

- Parking** *Our facility has a parking area for your use. Please help to keep this area clean. Vehicle maintenance, changing oil, washing cars, etc. is not permitted. See the Base Auto Hobby Shop for these purposes. Boats, motorcycles, trailers, etc. are permitted in parking area only on the day of arrival. Large, oversized vehicles must also be removed from the parking lots after your day of arrival. The Auto Hobby Shop has a parking area that is available to PCS and TDY personnel with oversized vehicles.*
- Payment** *All Air Force Lodging guests must provide a valid credit card at check in or be required to pay in advance with cash or check for anticipated room charges. Official travelers, TDY/PCS, must use the Government Travel Card (GTC) to make room reservations and to pay all lodging fees unless exempt from GTC use. Please contact the lodging manager for more information*
- Personal Effects** *Lodging is not responsible for your valuables. Personal Property should be secured in the in room safe or taken with you when you leave the room. Housekeepers are instructed not to disturb a guest's personal property at any time. Leaving items lying around the room results in your room limits the housekeeper's ability to provide proper service. Your assistance in keeping your room neat and orderly is greatly appreciated.*
- Pest Control** *The control of pests is an ongoing problem. The beetle, field mice, and numerous flying insects love the climate in this area. If you see any of these "unregistered guests," please call the front desk for prompt attention. You can help by properly discarding waste food items and keeping usable items in the refrigerator.*
- Pets** *Pets are not permitted in or around any Lodging facility. Guest will be assessed a \$150.00 charge for carpet and upholstery cleaning. A local area kennel listing is provided in this directory. Pet Friendly Family Units are available in the TLF building on McGuire on a first come, first served basis. Service Animals must be registered at check in and may accompany the guest.*
- Postage Stamps** *Postage stamps may be purchased at the post office or Base Exchange. Please refer to the base map*



- Quiet Hours** *Air Force personnel attend school on varied shifts and are sleeping during the day and mid evenings. Please be considerate. Quiet hours begin at 2200 hrs every evening. Noise, including radio and television volume, should be kept to a minimum, not to be heard outside the room*
- Radio Stations** *For local stations refer to listing in Television/Radio section in this directory.*
- Rental Cars** *Please refer to the rental care listing in this directory*
- Smoking Policy** *All lodging facilities at JB MDL are NONSMOKING. Guests will be assessed a \$150.00 cleaning and/or any damage charges for the extermination of quarters; cost of cleaning of carpet, upholstery, and drapes*
- Sundry Sales** *A variety of snacks, beverages, cigarettes, and sundry items may be purchased at the front desk. All Business Suites are fully stocked with sundries.*

OCCUPANT “DO AND DON'TS”

DO

- Notify a Guest Representative by dialing “0” from your room telephone if you have problems
- Clean up after yourself when using common areas of the building, i.e., laundry room, Fitness and Business Center areas, and Pavilion.
- Turn in your key upon checkout at the front desk
- Leave kitchen/kitchenette area clean and orderly, if so equipped
- Keep noise to a minimum

DON'T

- Remove furniture or equipment from room
- Tape, thumb tack, staple or nail anything to the walls, doors, cabinets or furnishings in the rooms, hallways, or kitchen
- **SMOKE IN THE GUEST ROOMS (A \$150.00 “DEEP CLEANING” FEE WILL BE ACCESSED)**
- **BURN CANDLES IN GUEST ROOMS**
- Tamper with fire extinguishers or alarms
- Attempt repairs of equipment or facilities (You could be held liable for damages)
- Leave the room unlocked
- Drive or park vehicles on grass
- Keep bicycles, auto parts, etc., in your room
- Display pornographic, offensive or prejudicial material in your room
- Keep weapon or ammunition in your room. For storage, call the Security Forces Desk at ext. 323-4000

ENERGY CONSERVATION TIPS

- Turn off lights when not in use.
- Turn heat/air down when you leave quarters
- Report leaking faucets and broken windows immediately
- Turn off radio and TV and unplug coffee pot when not in use.
- Keep exterior doors closed at all times.
- When air conditioning or heat is on, keep windows closed at all times

Energy conservation is important to us. You can help by observing these tips.

Occupant Responsibility

- As a registered guest, you are responsible for the conduct of your guests and/or visiting family members; their actions must not infringe on the rights of others.
- All utilities must be turned off while away from the room.
- Reimburse lodging for damage beyond fair wear and tear and for missing/destroyed government property determined to be caused by abuse or negligence on your part or by your guest.
- Compliance with fire, health and safety regulations
- Obtain appropriate care for your pets. Pets are authorized in “pet friendly” accommodations only unless approved by management.
- Store all valuables in personal lockers. Use locks when appropriate.
- Store and protect all perishable foods and open drinks.
- Cleanliness of cooking utensils, glassware, dishes, silverware, etc.
- Report the presence of rodents and insects.
- Report damage or the need of repairs by calling the front desk by dialing “0”.
- **DO NOT SMOKE IN ANY LODGING FACILITY.**

Fire Safety

Please familiarize yourself with the location of the nearest fire exit stairway. In the event of a fire, please move quickly, but calmly, to the nearest exit. It is mandatory that all fire or smoke incidents be reported to the fire department. Emergency evacuation maps are located on the inside of your room's door. **Please call "911" for Emergencies.**

Non-emergencies, call Front Desk at "0" or the Fire Department at 323-4000

Please help us by observing the following rules.

- Do not touch or tamper with the smoke detectors in living areas or bedrooms. If your smoke detector is activating, please contact the front desk.
- Do not tamper with fire extinguishers. Tampering or unnecessary discharge of fire extinguishers will result in your removal from the facilities.
- Do not smoke in room. All rooms are NONSMOKING.
- Do not store highly flammable liquids (gasoline, charcoal lighter, flammable paint, etc.) in your room
- Do not use unauthorized cooking or heating devices in your room. UL approved coffee pots are provided.
- If your room has a kitchen, do not leave cooking equipment unattended.
- Do not place hot appliances such as irons, coffee pots, etc., in closets, cabinets or drawers.
- Do not overload electrical circuits.
- Do not leave televisions, radios, or personal, electrical items on in your absence.
- Do follow good housekeeping practices.
- If detected, report low pressure fire extinguishers to the front desk.

Occupant Safety

Your safety and the security of your personal property are of the utmost concern to those of us who welcome you as our guest. We urge you to take advantage of the following suggestions

All American Inn is not responsible for your valuables. Do not leave money or valuables in your room. Please take such items with you or secure in your in room safe

When away from or while occupying your room, always lock your door even if you are just leaving for a few minutes.

Do not admit persons in your room without first making identification. Rooms have a "peep hole" provided in the door. If there is any doubt about a person's true identity or purpose, please contact the front desk.

Safeguard your key. If you do not wish to leave the property with your key, leave it with the Guest Services Desk upon departure and have a new key made upon return. Do not leave it in your room or in the door. Do not give your keys to others.

If you find a lock not working, contact the Reception Desk for immediate repairs. Secure all locking devices provided on windows and doors at all times.

Do not keep valuables inside parked vehicles.

Never discuss plans for staying away from lodging in front of strangers

Do not leave luggage unattended when checking out.

If you notice anything suspicious or alarming in nature or have need of any special assistance, please contact the Reception Desk immediately.

Warning Signals

SEVERE WEATHER:

Thunderstorm Watch-Heavy thunderstorm activity has been sighted. Prepare to take shelter

Thunderstorm Warning-Rain, storm winds, and possible hail. Seek Shelter

Tornado Watch-Weather conditions are favorable for the development of tornadoes.

Tornado Warning-Tornado has actually been sighted. Take shelter.

TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS

- Stay informed. Monitor the local radio or television station for the latest weather advisory
- If you are in the watch area, be prepared to take shelter. For protection against tornadoes, you should select a central hallway area or centrally located room on the lowest floor of your duty section or quarters away from windows, doorways, and wide ceilings
- Preposition sturdy tables, blankets, flashlights, etc. in the area selected for use during tornadoes
- Unless a tornado warning issued, you should not further interrupt your normal routine, except remain alert for the approach of threatening weather conditions or the termination of the tornado watch.

3-5 Minute Steady Tone-Alert Signal. Imminent peacetime emergencies only.

3-5 Minute Wavering Tone-Attack Warning. Actual attack is imminent or in progress. Take immediate shelter or other protective actions.

30-Second duration wavering or steady Tone-Test Signal. Testing of alert signal only. Take no action.

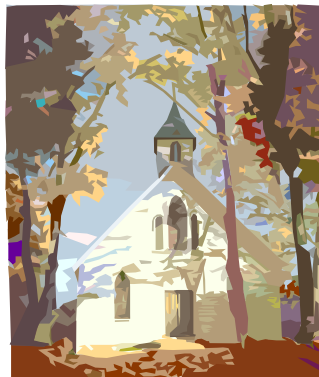

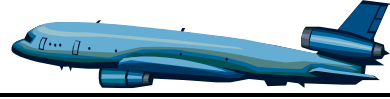
