



87FSS Youth Sports: 2024 Non-Competitive Cheer Registration Dates: 28 Oct 2024 – 15 Nov 2024



1. **REGISTRATION**: Registration is from Monday, 28 Oct 2024 through Friday, 15 Nov 2024 on our CYPBMS Parent Portal. For new CYPBMS Accounts, send an email to <u>87fss.jbmdl.youthsports@us.af.mil</u> requesting a CYPBMS Account. Include Sponsor's First/Last Name and the family's primary email address (preferably NOT your .mil address).

Step 1: ALL CYPBMS accounts must be completed prior to registering for Cheer. Complete your "Family Information", create your "Child Profile", enter your credit card information for payment into "Manage TAP Settings", and upload all required documents.

Step 2: From the "Home Page" of CYPBMS, register by selecting "Camp/Instructional" and select "2024/25 Cheerleading". Sessions are grouped according to youth's age. Payment will be processed Friday, 20 Jan 2025. Registrations will not be processed until all forms are uploaded and account is completed with all required information.

- 2. **COST:** The cost of our Non-Competitive Cheer is \$75 per youth for all ages. Payments will be processed Friday, 20 Jan 2025 on our CYPBMS Parent Portal. Cost includes team uniform: shell, skirt/skort, and pom poms. Not included are socks, spanx, or body wear. **The registration cost for returning Cheerleaders from Flag Football will be \$45 per youth for all ages, the cost is reduced for those cheerleaders, they will be able to use their uniform and poms from flag football season.**
- 3. **AGES:** Youth Non-Competitive Cheer serves youth ages 5-16 years old. Our START Smart Program is an instructional parent interactive program for 3- and 4-year-olds. Sessions for START Smart are Wednesdays at 1730 hrs. Youth will participate in the group according to their ages. The age groups are as follows but may change according to age/grade and registration numbers:

3 – 4yrs START Smart (Developmental Program)

5 – 6yrs Pee Wees

7 – 8yrs Minors

9 – 10yrs Jr Bantams

11 - 12yrs Sr Bantams

13-15yrs Juniors

- 4. **PHYSICALS AND IMMUNIZATION RECORDS:** Annual Physicals and Immunization Records are mandatory for youth in all ages to participate in Youth Sports Program. Physicals and Immunization (current Flu Shot Record) must be uploaded on your CYPBMS account prior to registration. You may request a Physical Form by emailing 87fss.jbmdl.youthsports@us.af.mil. Youth Sports will contact parents/guardians if any additional documents are needed.
- 5. **EXPECTATIONS:** Attending the Mandatory Parents Meeting allows you the opportunity to meet your Volunteer Coach and receive important information on the upcoming season. If for some reason you are not able to attend the Mandatory Parents Meeting, please call the Youth Sports Office at 609-754-5912 or the Front Desk at 609-754-5437 before the season practice begins.
- 6. **PRACTICES AND GAMES:** The 87 FSS Youth Sports Program policy for cancellation of practices and games due to inclement weather or for unforeseen safety conditions; Heat Stress Category 5 Black, heavy rain down pours, fields deem unsafe playing conditions, and any signs of lighting with thunderstorms. For any of these reasons, the Youth Sports office would cancel any youth sports activities for the day. If you are unsure of practice or game times, please contact your coach or the JB-MDL Youth Sports Office. The JB-MDL Youth Sports Program welcomes all forms of positive reinforcement and enthusiasm from all participants.
- 7. **COACHES:** All volunteer coaches must be certified by a Youth Sports Clinician and through the National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA). See Important Dates on reverse side for the next certification class. The JB-MDL Youth Sports Program adopts the NYSCA standards of safety and coaching etiquette. The NYSCA teaches psychological and emotional needs of children while in youth sports, basic sport skills, sportsmanship and emphasis on participation rather than winning. In addition, each coach must complete an installation records check (IRC) which will be checked through the McGuire Family Advocacy Program.

- 8. **TRANSPORTATION:** Transportation will not be provided by the JB-MDL Youth Sports Office. It is the sole responsibility of the parents.
- 9. **REFUND POLICY:** Refunds will not be offered after 1 Feb 2025. Unfortunately, program costs are fixed costs; therefore, the Youth Sports Program incurs costs whether a youth finishes a complete season or not.
- 10. REQUESTS: <u>We will attempt to honor special requests found under the comments section of the registration form for Start Smart only.</u> However, due to the number of requests, we cannot guarantee your request will be honored.
