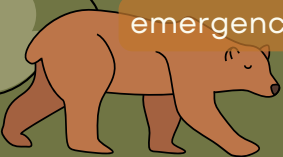

POLICIES



Parking & Registration

Park in your assigned space only. No subletting is permitted. All guests and vehicles must be registered.

Vehicle Maintenance

Performing maintenance on RVs or cars within the campground is prohibited.

Campsite Issues

Report any problems with your campsite or hookups immediately. Do not move to a different site without authorization.

Caretaker Responsibility

Children and pets must be supervised at all times.

Respect the Space

Clean up after yourself and your pets. Dispose of all trash and recycling in the correct receptacles.

Rebooking Policy

You must wait 48 hours after departure before making a new reservation. Non-compliance will result in a loss of reservation privileges.

Stay Duration Policy

There is a maximum of 180 reservation days per household or vehicle, per calendar year.

Fire Responsibility

Fires are only allowed in designated fire pits. They must not be left unattended and must be completely extinguished before you leave.

Risk & Responsibility

ODR is not responsible for theft or damage to personal property from acts of nature or other incidents.

Operational Availability

Campsite availability is subject to change based on FPCON/HPCON levels, emergency closures, or official directives.

Damage Accountability

You will be charged for any damages or replacements if the campsite and equipment are not left in their original condition.

Fishing Permits

A fishing license and a JB MDL permit are required to use any base ponds or lakes. Permits are available at jbmdl.isportman.net

Pet Policy

Pets must be leashed at all times. All pets must have current vaccinations. Pets may not be left unattended. Excessive barking, howling, or other disturbances are not permitted. Pets displaying aggressive, vicious, or unruly behavior is strictly prohibited and owners will be asked to remove them. Owners are responsible for *immediately* cleaning up and properly disposing of all pet waste.

Failure to comply with this pet policy may result in being asked to leave the campground without a refund.

RANGE 14

All campers must be registered with ODR to utilize this camp area

- 12 back-in sites. (Site #1 has no sewer connections)
- Site #5 & #6 are 20 feet in length.
- Campers will only park in assigned slot on your rental contract.
- Placard must be displayed in camper window or place holder adjacent to site number. Campers are responsible for the neatness and cleanliness of their campsite.
- No open fires.
- Showers are available to campers and Rod and Gun club members.
- Has shared water connections.
- Offers 30 amp and 50 amp.
- Campers will use connections closest to assigned slot.
- Vehicle speed limit at FAMCAMP is NTE 5mph. Campsites have their own sewage hook-ups.

Dumping Instructions

- Hold grey and black water until tanks are almost full. Connect hose to holding tank and insert other end in drain line. Release black waste, follow with flush using gray waste.

Reminder

- Dump station is not a sewer or septic system. It is a holding tank. Failure to follow the above can result in clogs and backups.

Trails access (for dog walking)

- Immediate camp ground area, behind the bathrooms and picnic area. Not near the skeet shooting range or any adjacent wooded areas (shared active ranges).



WINTER PROCEDURES

During winter it is mandatory to turn off the water and disconnect the hose after filling the water tank.

Prep for Winter:

Insulate the pipes draining into the tanks with foam pipe insulation.

Wrap your sewer hose in insulation or heat tape.

Fresh Water Hose:

Consider buying heated water hose to prevent freeze-ups or bursting. (Controlled via thermostat & requires AC power to operate) Keep all hoses & cables off the ground or out of snow.

Fill your fresh water tank, then disconnect your hose, shut off water from the campground and let the water drain out from hose.

Other:

If water pump is located in an insulated exterior storage area, a small space heater can help keep it from freezing.

CAMP DIX

Primitive tent camping only. All guests must be registered with ODR to utilize tent site area

- Porta-potty is located in the parking lot area.
- Do not leave any food/beverages or coolers unattended. Follow Leave-No-Trace ethics.
- Gather kindling/firewood from downed trees or purchase locally.
- Be advised, poison ivy is abundant in the areas surrounding the campsite.
- No open fires; use open fire rings available.
- Fire extinguishers available at ODR office

WILLOW POND

All campers must be registered with ODR to utilize this camp area

- 8 back-in sites.
- Campers will only park in assigned slot on your rental contract.
- Placard must be displayed in camper window or place holder adjacent to site number. Campers are responsible for the neatness and cleanliness of their campsite.
- No open fires.
- Restrooms located on the right of the campsite entrance. (no showers)
- Has water and electric connection.
- Offers 20 amp and 30 amp with 110 volt. Campers will use connections closest to assigned slot.
- Vehicle speed limit at FAMCAMP is not to exceed 5mph.
- Dump station located on the left of the campground entrance.
- No dumping grey water above ground.

Dumping Instructions

- Wear gloves.
- Secure drain hose to your RV/camper. Place drain end of hose into sewer opening. Ensure to secure the end of hose in to the dump port.
- Open the black tank valve, then the grey tank valve.
- Drain the RV tank valves. Please flush cement slab after dumping waste.
